

To all Michigan Region Pastors, Delegates, and Church Leaders:
 A special nominating committee has been formed by the Regional
 Oversight Council to begin the process of searching for a new
 Regional Director of the Michigan Region of the Missionary
 Church. Rev. Jim Keller has served in this capacity for almost
 twenty years. He is stepping down at the end of June, 2019, as he
 completes his fifth term.

The committee is calling our churches and pastors to two
 things. First, we are calling our Region to pray for God's direc-
 tion and wisdom as this search begins. We need the Lord's
 help! Then we are asking pastors, delegates, church leaders, and
 church members to prayerfully submit the names of those they
 might recommend for this position. The Regional Director must be
 a male ordained pastor in the Missionary Church. He should have
 the gifts and abilities to lead our Region into the future and to cast
 a vision of where God is leading us. He should be a person filled
 with God's Spirit and wisdom. If you have such a person in mind,
 write or email the chairman of the nominating committee, Pastor
 Doug Connelly ([1481 N. Gale Rd., Davison, MI 48423](mailto:doug@davisonmc.org)
 or doug@davisonmc.org), by March 1. We probably will not ask
 or contact every person who is recommended, but we will give every
 person our consideration. Recommendations must be in writing
 and signed by the person doing the recommending (or identified as
 the sender in an email). No anonymous recommendations will be
 accepted.
