The personal item we are collecting this month is shampoo.



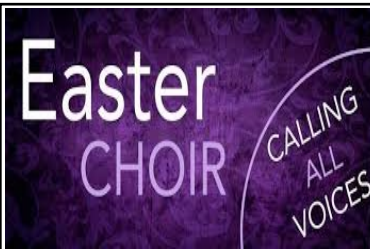

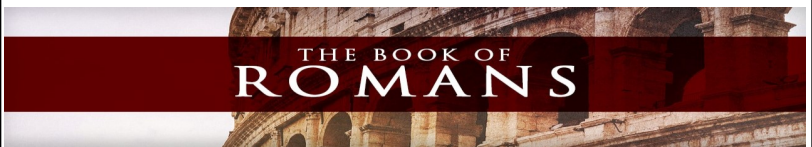
### ATTENTION!!!
