## **Four Easy Steps**

**1.**

### **Set the Time**

### **Set up the Tech**

Play the online video and follow along. The presentation includes worship songs, a Bible story, a Bible verse, and much more. The idea is to participate, not just watch. Follow the prompts and join in. As you get more familiar with the format, we suggest you choose different family members to help "lead" the different elements as you watch.

### **Play**

Following your family worship, we have suggested a game or activity that connects with the lesson of the week.

## PLAY - The Humming Game

The "humming game" involves choosing one person who is "it" and a task for that person to perform, such as standing in front of the refrigerator. The person who is "it" goes out of the room while the group chooses the task and decides on a song to hum. The "it" person returns to the room and stands in the middle of the floor. The group hums softly. The "it" person begins to walk around the room. As "it" gets closer to the task, the group hums louder. When the task is achieved, the group cheers for the child who was "it."

Have you ever played a game, and someone bragged and boasted when they won?  
How does it make you feel when people brag and boast?  
Why do you think it is important to be humble?

## SHARE - He Came

Teach your kids to tell the story of Jesus by learning to draw the five Jesus symbols with these lessons over the next five weeks. For this lesson, the story is: He Came. The symbol is a downward arrow. Practice drawing the symbol and connecting it to "He Came."

### **Series Verse**

### **The Point of the Lesson:**

The students will learn that the people hoped Jesus would become their king, however, Jesus humbled himself and would not accept such a position as an earthly king. Jesus taught us to be humble.

### **The Prayer for Each Child:**

Our prayer is that each child will come to understand that Jesus calls us to be people of humility, not people of pride and arrogance.

Humility - putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve.
