2019 Operation Christmas Child Stats

- 30,660 shoeboxes were packed in East Central Michigan (Oakland, Macomb, Genesee, and Shiawassee counties)
- 8,801,607 shoeboxes were packed nationwide.
- Nearly 11 million shoeboxes were collected worldwide.
- The shoeboxes from our church went to Peru.



Peru is located on the western coast of South America. It contains a part of the Amazon rainforest as well as Andes mountains, where the ancient Incan city of Machu Picchu is a popular tourist attraction. Samaritan's Purse began distributing gift-filled shoeboxes there in 1997 and launched The Greatest Journey, our follow-up discipleship program, in this nation in 2010.
