The **Flushing Christian Outreach Center (FCOC)** is continuing to provide food to those in need during this time of crisis. The financial burden is great. Since the start of the Coronavirus pandemic, FCOC has seen a 39% increase in requests for food. Many food items regularly purchased at much-reduced pricing from the Food Bank of Eastern MI are currently not available.

This has forced FCOC to make purchases at local grocery stores at a much higher price. With the higher prices and increased number of people needing food, FCOC has projected a cash shortage of \$43,000 to \$65,000 - depending upon how fast the economy recovers.

To help raise the needed money, American Metal Roofs and an anonymous donor have offered to match donations up to \$10,000.

**A special fundraising campaign will be held from now through May 10th for these matching funds.**

It will be decided by May 26th if the June 8-12 Work Week will take place. If it is canceled, then we may reschedule it for later in the summer if possible.



## **Brown City Family Camp July 30—August 9**

Within the ability of the leadership of Brown City Camp, we will have Family Camp in some form during the normal camp time.

1. We are holding to the hope, that it is the Lord's plan, we can have camp as normal. If not..
2. We will be following the guidelines set forth by the government. If we are limited in the number that can gather, we will put together a team that will broadcast the services from the Eastman Tabernacle. Numbers of people may be limited and space or distancing enforced. This may restrict who can attend services.
3. If we cannot provide a safe assembly, we will broadcast services from the tabernacle without people in the building and you may not be allowed to camp.
4. As a last resort, if travel is restricted we will work with the speakers to provide recordings for use to broadcast. We will do as many churches are doing today.

2. Support the decision made by: the camp board and the government
3. Plan to be at camp! However it looks.
